



GNPS Card System

This system replaces the 'Loss of Privileges' system and will commence at the beginning of Term 3, 2025.

Students will be placed on either a Yellow Card List **OR** a Red Card List, if they are meeting one of the following set of conditions:

1. **A student is placed onto a Behaviour Monitoring Card.**
2. **A student is placed on a Language Monitoring Card.**
3. **A student is placed on a Formal Caution.**
4. *A student returns from Suspension – this will result in an automatic 2-week card placement.*

The following will occur when a student is placed on a card:

 GNPS Yellow Card	<i>Student on a Yellow Card may not be able to participate in:</i> • <i>School excursions</i> • <i>Movie days</i> • <i>Pool days</i> • <i>Special school events</i> • <i>Representative events</i> • <i>Sporting days</i> <i>Exceptions to this may occur in consultation with your child's Team Leader.</i>
 GNPS Red Card	<i>Student on a Red Card will not be able to participate in the following:</i> • <i>School excursions</i> • <i>Movie days</i> • <i>Pool days</i> • <i>Special school events</i> • <i>Representative events</i> • <i>Sporting days</i>

Student that meets conditions 1-3 will remain on a card until the successful completion of these process.
