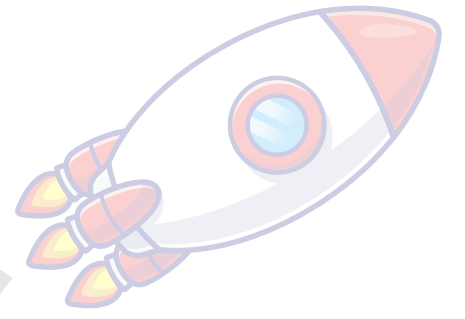


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ST JOHN THE BAPTIST OSHC PROGRAM NEWSLETTER

Morning Highlights: Kicking Off the Day with Energy and Joy

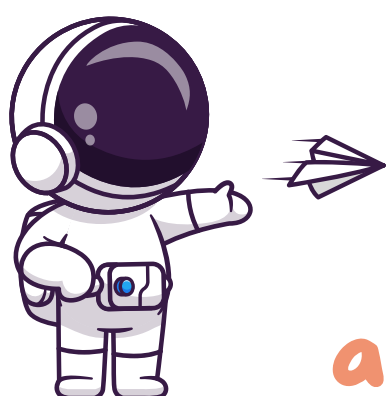
Each morning began with child-led play experiences that encouraged movement, collaboration, and joyful connection.

Four Square became a favourite across multiple mornings, promoting quick thinking, fair play, and communication as children welcomed others into the game.

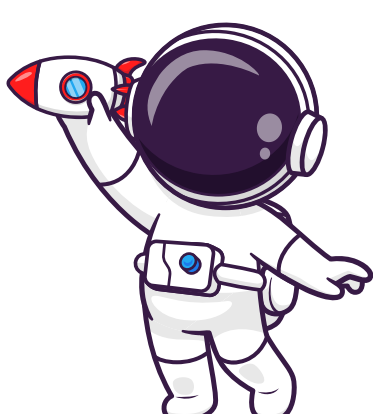

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Afternoon Adventures: Movement, Creativity & Connection

Afternoons were filled with rich and varied experiences that supported learning and social development:

A highlight for many was time spent with our chickens, where children gently held, observed, and cared for the animals — building empathy, responsibility, and confidence.

Sensory play with kinetic sand brought children together to mould, shape, and create in a calming, hands-on environment.

A group of children collaborated on a creative treasure hunt using invisible ink and watercolour clues. This magical, child-led experience sparked curiosity, teamwork, and problem-solving as they worked together to decode hidden messages.

In another inspiring moment, students built a colourful marble run using teamwork and trial-and-error to perfect their design, celebrating their success with every marble that completed the course.

Sporting achievements were also recognised this week, with two students being selected for Regional netball following recent wins — demonstrating the power of persistence, dedication, and team spirit.

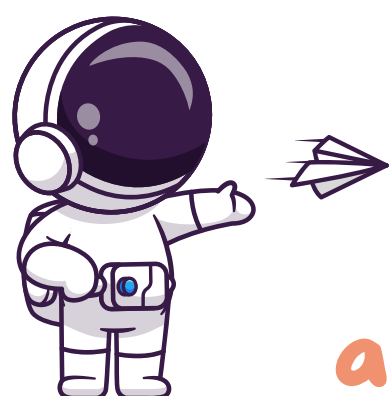
Games that Build Bonds
