### SOME QUESTIONS YOU MAY LIKE TO ASK:

Whether you attend an Open Day or make contact via the phone or online chat, you may consider asking some of the following questions ....

- How do I apply for this course?
- If I don't get the ATAR required are there other pathways to access this course?
- Are there any Early Offer / Alternative Application processes available, eg Aspire Program at La Trobe?
- What are the entry requirements i.e. Prerequisites?
- Are there any 'Extra Requirements' for students applying to this course other than ATAR? Eg audition or folio
- What careers do graduates from this course go on to? What are the employment rates for graduates?
- Is there on-campus accommodation available at this university? If yes, what are the costs involved? Does this include food? How do I apply? If no, is there other accommodation assistance available?
- Can I defer this course?
- Am I entitled to a scholarship? If so, what scholarships are available and how do I apply?
- Is this course Commonwealth Supported? What exactly does this mean? If no, would I be able to apply for Fee Help, and how does this work?
- Please explain the Acceptance and Enrolment process.
- How do I go about selecting my specific subjects for this course? (also referred to as Majors and Minors), eg an
   Arts degree will have several different areas of study to select from)
- What would be the starting date of the course?
- Is there an Orientation Week?
- How is the University year structured? Eg 2 semesters or 3 trimesters etc.
- What equipment/texts will I require for this course? Can you give me an idea of costs involved?
- How many 'contact' hours for classes are there each week? Are many lectures and tutorials online?
- Will the course run at this campus for the duration of the course or will I have to move campuses?
- How is the course taught? Eg lectures / tutorials etc. Please describe a typical week for students
- What other facilities are available to students? Eg medical services, chemists, career advice, counseling etc
- What activities/clubs and societies are available to students? Eg sporting facilities, drama clubs etc
- What help can I get with study skills?

#### TIPS AND SUGGESTIONS ©

- \* Make sure you Register Open Days usually have an expectation you will register your interest/attendance
- Look through the Open Day schedule and PLAN AHEAD so you know exactly when your sessions are on.
- ❖ If you want to live 'On Res' see if you can do a tour at the Open Day ask about the application process, cost etc
- If you are looking into a course in the creative industries or performing arts ask about the Audition process and/or folios required.
- Write notes while at Open Day sessions ... you won't remember everything you are told. Take contact details of any staff you find helpful, they may be very a handy contact later on.
