



1:1 Technology Update – Open Day

We are excited to share an update on Glengarry Primary School's successful 1:1 Technology Program. Throughout the year, our commitment to enhancing education through technology integration has had remarkable results. This initiative has continued to be woven into the curriculum and has fostered a dynamic learning environment where students are empowered to produce exceptional work.

We extend our gratitude to the students and families for their active participation and support. The response to the program has been overwhelmingly positive, reflecting a shared dedication to nurturing innovative educational outcomes.

Below is an overview of the current number of students who participate in the 1:1 Technology program by bringing their own iPad to school.

- Room 5: 96% of students are bringing their own device to school
- Room 6: 96% of students are bringing their own device to school
- Room 12: 96% of students are bringing their own device to school
- Room 11: 85% of students are bringing their own device to school
- Room 9 (Year 5 only): 100% of students are bringing their own device to school

Throughout the academic year, our 1:1 Technology teachers will actively participate in more than 50 hours of dedicated professional learning. This comprehensive learning experience, facilitated by Next Learning and Apple, is strategically designed to further elevate the already exemplary technological proficiency of our teachers.

As we begin planning for 2024, we would like to invite **parents of students in Year 3 and 4 in 2024** to attend our Technology Open day on Tuesday 29 August. Our 1:1 Technology Program begins when students reach Year 4, however if your child is in a multi-age 3/4 class, we would request that an iPad be provided for that student.

The Open Day is an opportunity for the 1:1 Technology classes to showcase their work and the skills they have developed during the year. Parents will be required to register for the event the session is limited to **20 parents**. Rooms 11 and 12 will be hosting this event.
