If your child is entering Year 4 in 2024 our purchasing portal through Winthrop is now open, devices are offered at a discounted education price. It is recommended that students bring a 9th Gen iPad that runs iOS 16 as a minimum requirement, the iPad must have 64gb storage. At this time, we would also request parents of students who will be in Year 3 in 2024, to please notify the school if you would be willing to purchase an iPad for your child if they were to be in a multi-aged class with Year 4 students. <u>1:1 Technology Program</u> TOP 10 THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

- 1. Glengarry Primary School has a 1:1 Technology Program for students in Year 4 Year 6, and for students who are in a 3/4 class, in 2024.
- Parents will need to purchase an iPad, it must be 8th generation iPad or above, and it must run iOS
 16 at a minimum. The iPad must have a minimum of 64gb of storage. Please note this may change depending on any Apple announcements.
- 3. It is highly recommended that parents purchase a keyboard for the iPad (not Bluetooth) and a stylus pen. These can be purchased through the Winthrop parent portal.
- 4. Families can purchase an iPad at an education price from Winthrop Australia. Please use the parent portal for purchasing using the following link: <u>https://sales.winaust.com.au/shop/glengarryps</u>
- 5. If your family already owns an iPad that meets the above specifications, your child may use that device at school, although the iPad will be reconfigured, i.e. restored to factory settings.
- **6.** Your child's device will be reconfigured because an MDM (Mobile Device Management) will be installed onto the device at the school's cost. For more information about MDM's please use the following link: <u>https://www.jamf.com/education/#jamf-teacher</u>
- 7. Students without a device will have access to a shared iPad. This device will not be allowed to go home with students.

- 9. Student iPads will be school managed, this means parents will not be able to add or takeaway apps on the device.
