The purpose:

This is a school showcase. It is not a contest – which means, no judges, no winners and losers and no points awarded. It is all about building up students' confidence and showcasing their talents.

The organisation:

The awareness will be carried out in week 4 of term 1. Students will be allowed 2 weeks after the awareness to decide on an item to perform at the Talent Show. By week 7, students (individual or groups) should register their performance. A schedule for practice for individuals/groups will be put up after performances have been registered. The Art room and Music room will be used for practices.

The first screening session will be in week 3 of term 2, and the second will be in week 5. After the 2nd screening session, the performances that pull out will not re-register 'We would like to see students get on stage and perform an act they can be proud of, and not to just goof around on stage.'

There will be two whole school rehearsals prior to the actual show.

Talents may include

- Vocal – soloist or group
- Instrument – soloist or group, with singing or without
- Dance – soloist or group
- Magic tricks – rubriks, yoyo, cards, etc
- Individual Shows – juggling, balloon animal show, origami, comedy
- Poetry recital – soloist or group
- Puppet show
- Skits (voiced/mimed)
- Others.....

Rules and eligibility

- * The show is open to prep to 10 students of LIS only.
- * Participants may perform individually or as a group. A group is 2 or more students.
- * Groups are not restricted to classes. A group may consist of a mixture of students from any grade but is limited to 8 participants, not more.
- * To participate, individual students or groups need to fill in a registration form and have it submitted to the committee by or before the due date.
- * Students who are part of a group should submit their registration form as group registration.
- * Maximum number of participants in a performance is 8
- * Recommended length for performance is 2 minutes, except for an act, 3 minutes.
- * Absolutely no profanity or insensitive subject matter will be permitted.
- * Costumes must be appropriate for all age groups. Remember this is a school event.
- * Acts are responsible for their own props and costumes. However, this should be made known to the committee at the 1st screening time.
- * If your act requires recorded accompanying music/sound effects, the music must be provided to the Talent Show Committee after the 1st screening session, and it must be labelled with your name/group's name and song name.
- * All performances will be screened for appropriateness by the talent show committee.
- * If you cancel your performance after the second screening, you will not be allowed to re-register your group.
- * 2 rehearsals will be held, in the last two weeks, prior to the actual show.
- * Only LIS students are allowed to participate.
- * Parents are encouraged to help their child/children practise and prepare for their performance.
