- Each student is only permitted to enter the competition once (multiple entries will not be accepted).
- The student and a parent/carer must read all the competition Terms and Conditions (including the Village Roadshow tickets terms and conditions) and understand the requirements of the prizes before entering. Online student and parent declarations will need to be completed when submitting an entry. Entries that do not meet the declaration requirements may be deemed ineligible.
- This competition is open to students who live within the Ballina Shire Council boundaries.
- All category winners must be available on Thursday 25 April 2024 to attend the Ballina RSL Sub-Branch ANZAC Day March, Commemoration Service and Official Luncheon at the RSL Club. Students will be required to wear their full school uniform. Students attending the Official Luncheon will need to be escorted and supervised by one parent/carer. Please note that ANZAC Day 2024 is during the NSW Autumn school holiday break.

- On ANZAC Day photographers and TV news crews will be attending the March and Commemoration Service. All persons attending the may appear in photos and video footage taken by these crews. The images and footage may be featured on social media, in newspapers and on commercial television news shows.



- **The first-place winners of each category will be invited to attend** a Ballina RSL Sub-Branch monthly meeting (date to be determined) to discuss their winning entries with the veterans.
- The competition will open at 9 am on **Tuesday 12 March 2024.**
- The competition will close at **5 pm, Tuesday 2 April**. Late entries will not be accepted.
- **Entries will be judged by a panel** of veterans from the Ballina RSL Sub-Branch, representatives from the Ballina RSL Club and the Ballina ANZAC Day Coordinator.
- All Category winners will be notified via the parent/carer phone number and email address provided on the online entry form by Monday 8 April 2024.
- One of each type of Village Roadshow passes to be won per age group. Age groups comprise of Years 10-12, Years 7-9 and Years 3-6. Tickets are non-transferable and cannot be redeemed for cash or other prizes. Ballina RSL Sub-branch reserves the right to refuse or substitute awarded Passes.
- The Ballina RSL Sub-Branch and RSL Club reserve the right to select another winner **if an entrant cannot satisfy or has breached the terms and conditions.**
- The Ballina RSL Sub-Branch and RSL Club have no responsibility to accept late, lost or misdirected entries.
