


The Churchlands Primary School Netball Club 2025 Information Handbook

Registration login

If you are registering a player who has participated before then you will be a return user and will have a login ID and Password via PlayHQ. Sign in using your email and password, if you have forgotten those details then click on the "Forgot Password" you will be able to retrieve the information using your email address.

If you are a first time participant follow the "I don't have an account yet" and continue.

Medical information

Please disclose any relevant health and medical information during the online registration process. All medical information is confidential to the Club Co-ordinator and the individual player's coach and team manager. If a new condition or injury occurs during the season please inform your child's coach immediately, this will ensure appropriate care and precautions are put in place.

All players are covered with insurance for netball activities. Should an injury occur at PNA it is important that it is reported to the first aid room on the day.

Code of conduct

The Club and its members agree to adopt the Churchlands Primary Schools' *Churchlands Way* ethos, which is to:

- Take Responsibility
- Follow instructions
- Respect everyone and everything
- Participate and aim to do your best
- Appreciate and include others

Players

- Will agree to attend all training sessions and games, unless sick or injured. If unable to attend, the coach must be given reasonable notice.
- > Will agree to happily play in the position allocated by the coach.
- Will agree to address the coach, umpires, team mates as well as opposing players with respect at all times.
- Be aware that you are representing your school and will conduct yourself in an appropriate manner. Above all display good sportsmanship at all times.
- > Will agree to accept decisions made by the umpire.

Parents

- > Will ensure your child carries out the above 'code of conduct'.
- ➢ Will support any decisions made by the coach and or umpires.
- > Will be a model of good sports behaviour.
- > Will be courteous in communication with the coaches, umpires, players.

Grievance and dispute resolution procedure

Parents who have a grievance or any concerns are encouraged to bring the matter to the attention of the netball committee for discussion and resolution. This can be done in person or via email to any coach/committee member or the club coordinator. Issues that cannot be resolved via the committee can be directed to the P&C executive committee.

Coaches and Managers

- Will adhere to the Official Rules of Netball and the Competition Rules and Policies of the Perth Netball Association as outlined in their competition handbook and to relay these to their players and parents/carers.
- > Will provide to the players, weekly training, guidance and game resources as necessary.
- Will attend and coach weekly match games at Matthews Netball Centre.
- Will organize Umpire/s and the payment of these, through parent contribution.
- > Will communicate all relevant information to players and parents/carers.
- > Will be a model of good sports behaviour.
- > Will agree to accept all players assigned to the team.

Team selection

Teams are selected with the best interest of the entire Club in mind, not just individual teams or players; and will be undertaken in accordance with the following points.

- Subject to numbers in each age group, teams will have 8 to 10 players. A team is not full until it reaches 10 players, late registrants will be accepted if there is room in a team.
- > Players will play in their age group unless they demonstrate exceptional ability & skills.
- > Players will be placed into teams considering an even spread ability and skill level.
- In an effort to be as inclusive as possible requests to be in a team with one or two friends will be considered. Consideration will also be dependent on even spread of ability and team balance.
- New players coming into the Club will be placed into a team according to skill level friendship and availability.
- > This is a collaborative process between the coaches and the coordinator.
- Please note that the coordinator is privy to confidential and sensitive information during the team selection process.

Grading

As stated by the PNA and NetSetGo for teams in Year 2 to 6, individual player grading is at the discretion of each club. It is our Club's decision that individual grading will not be conducted, as an even spread of ability within each team is preferred. The Club Coordinator registers each team with a PNA starting division. The PNA competition committee then considers and allocates into divisions. In 2025, for Junior Year 6, the first 3 rounds of the season are PNA "Grading rounds".

Court time

Coaches need to ensure that each player receives equal time on and off the court throughout the season regardless of ability. It advised a record is kept to do so.

Players arriving later than 10 minutes prior to their game run the risk of missing the first quarter of the game where the coach has had to arrange for a substitute, and coaches are responsible for communicating this and the importance of 'warming up' before a game with their parents.

Players (parents/carers) must inform a coach of an absence at a game or training as this means the team could be subject to a game forfeit, which incurs a fine for The Club. Coaches must communicate this with their parents/carers.

Uniform



The Churchlands Netball Club uniform consists of the Churchlands Netball Club shirt and a navy blue skort/shorts/leggings. The uniform is compulsory and must be worn at each game. Teams can be fined by the PNA if the approved uniform isn't worn. The Churchlands Netball shirt will be provided to each player. It should be noted that the uniform shirt is **ON LOAN** for the season and must be returned in an acceptable condition at the end of the season.

From 2025 the club will be offering an optional netball dress that can be purchased as the players own for \$75. There are sample sizes available to try on at the uniform shop on Tuesday from 8:35am until 9:00am prior to purchase. Please note that no payments will be taken at the uniform shop for netball dresses, all payments for netball dresses are to be made through Qkr!

All orders for netball dresses are required to be received by 05/02/25 to be forwarded to Wanneroo Uniforms for manufacture. No refunds or exchanges will be provided as the netball dresses are a made to order item.

PNA training and education sessions and clinics

Each year the PNA runs development programs aimed at upskilling players and coaches and umpires. The following are some of the clinics and sessions that are available now

Perth Netball Association NET Program – Term 1 2025

NET Program is an 8 week clinic to learn the netball basics and make some friends. The NET program is for participants aged 5 - 7. It has been developed to provide children in **Pre-Primary and Years 1** with the best possible learning and playing experience to develop a positive introduction to netball, ensuring enjoyment and continued participation.

NET Program provides skill activities, minor games, and modified matches in a fun and safe environment. The weekly program is coordinated by accredited coaches to ensure a quality experience for all participants.

Cost is **\$107.13**. All Participants are required to register and pay online.
