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### Early Stage 1/ Stage 1 Term 1 Homework

#### **Home Reading:**

At Rydalmere Public School, home readers are decodable texts. These are books specifically written for students to practise their decoding and blending skills. We suggest that students read their decodable reader 4 times each week. Your child's classroom teacher will allocate a reader each week using the online Decodable Readers Australia platform. To login to the online Decodable Reader Library and access your child's allocated reader either go to the login page by holding a camera to the QR code on your student ID card or type in the URL <a href="https://www.draonline.com.au">www.draonline.com.au</a>. Next, type in the username and password or scan the QR code from the student ID card that your child has been given. If your child has misplaced their Decodable Readers Australia student ID card and password, please don't hesitate to reach out to their teacher for assistance. Your child will receive their home reading log in Week 5.

#### **Sight Words and Spelling Activities:**

Each week, students will receive a **sight word practice worksheet** and an **I can spell worksheet** to reinforce their learning in the classroom. These activities will help consolidate their understanding of sight words and spelling patterns, supporting their reading and writing development. Please encourage your child to complete their homework each week to build confidence and fluency in their spelling skills.

#### **Homework Reminder**

Home reading logs, sight word practice, and spelling homework are all due on **Friday** each week. Please ensure your child's homework is returned in a clearly labelled display folder. Thank you for your cooperation and support!

#### **Weather Project Task:**

This term, students will explore how daily and seasonal changes in our environment affect everyday life, focusing on observing, recording, investigating, and reporting on the local weather. As part of their learning, students will record weather patterns over a two-week period during **Week 6 and Week 7**. Additionally, students will research a specific type of weather, such as sunny, rainy, snowy, stormy, or windy. They will use their research to plan and create a diorama inside a shoebox (or similar box) that creatively showcases their chosen weather. Further information on the project task will be handed out **in Week 5**.
