

As part of our ongoing commitment to enhancing the experience for our families, we are conducting our yearly family survey. This initiative is important as it allows us to gather valuable insights directly from families about their experiences with us and identify areas where we can improve.



Upcoming Vacation Care Reminders

As we head into our Autumn Vacation care, some important reminders for old and new families:

- BREAKFAST is served between 7.30 8.15 am. If your child arrives after these times, please ensure they eat before they arrive.
- AFTERNOON tea is provided at the service.
- PLEASE pack a hat, morning tea, lunch, and a refillable water bottle. To ensure food does not spoil, please place cool packs in their lunchboxes.
- PLEASE do NOT pack food with NUTS as we are a nut-free zone.
- CHILDREN will need to wear sensible, closed-in, walking shoes, and a top that covers their shoulders, and bring a hat, sunscreen, raincoat (on wet days), and a suitable backpack.
- MEDICATION A medication form must be completed. The medication container must have the child's name clearly labelled on it and handed to staff on the day.
- EPI PENS and Ventolin need to be handed to staff on the day.
- CHILDREN often participate in messy activities so please do not wear their best outfits. Please pack swimmers, a towel, and a change of clothes for all days in summer as we may have spontaneous water play.
- CHILDREN are NOT permitted to bring mobile phones or other electrical devices to vacation care unless on the program. In-expensive toys are permitted; however, Gowrie NSW OSHC will take no responsibility for these items.
- CHILDREN are allowed to bring their bikes and scooters to vacation care. Helmets are essential. Roller skates or rollerblades are NOT allowed

In the mornings, we also have the middle demountable open for quiet, mindful practices, the Kindy demountable for age-appropriate pretend play, and the Big demountable for senior children to do homework, read books, and participate in board games. Reminders

Non-Notification of Absence Fees Now Apply:

As we informed families at the end of last year, we will be charging a Non-Notification of Absence Fee during Before School Care (BSC) and After School care (ASC).

To avoid this fee, we ask families to send us a notification through an email or text message, to inform us of their child's absence. For BSC, notification needs to occur before 8 am that morning, and ASC before 2 pm that afternoon. The fee is \$5 and will be automatically added to bills at the end of each week.

Extra-curricular activities pickup

Our extra-curricular activities procedure requires parents to sign and submit the permission to release form which includes the time, days and session that their child will be attending the activity. Educators assemble all the children going to the activity and hand them over to the teacher in charge of the activity, who then brings them back to Gowrie OSHC once the activity is completed. The permission form required can be found on Story Park, or you can seek a physical copy from one of our staff members during the service.

If you are picking up your child from the extracurricular activity, please let our Educators know as we need to account for all children that have been dropped off to activities.

Missing Items at Gowrie

It has recently been reported that children have been losing their items, e.g., key chains, Pokémon cards, etc, at Gowrie OSHC. To address the importance of respecting personal belongings, we have spoken with all children about the need to take care of their items and to ensure they do not take things that do not belong to them. It is important to address this behaviour early to help them understand the consequences and learn from their actions. We encourage open communication and would appreciate your support in discussing this with your child. Understanding the reasons behind such behaviour and reinforcing the importance of honesty and respect for others' property can make a significant difference. Thank you for your assistance and cooperation.
