FREE WORKSHOP APPLIED SUICIDE INTERVENTION SKILLS TRAINING (ASIST)

Most people with thoughts of suicide don't want to die - they are just struggling to bear the pain of living in the moment. Through their words and actions, they usually send invitations to others for help. Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST) is a two-day interactive workshop in suicide first-aid that teaches you how to recognise when someone may be at risk of suicide and how to work with them to create a plan that will support their immediate safety.

ASIST provides important life skills so we encourage anyone aged 16 years or older who wants to make a difference to take the training. This training is organised with the support of the Seeds of Hope Suicide Prevention Network. No prerequisite experience, training or qualifications are required.
